# Competitors' notes, competition rules

## Registration

- 1 Please collect your numbers from competitor registration in the Track Room at least one hour before your event. This is particularly important for track events so that there is enough time for competitors to be seeded when there are heats, for lanes to be drawn and for this information to be distributed to the start and finish, judges, photofinish, announcers, etc. You will wear the same numbers in all events that you have entered, so look after them and do not fold or mutilate them.
- 2 **Whether you are competing on the track or the field, you MUST report to registration before your first event on each day of competition.** Everyone competing on Sunday MUST register, even if they competed on Saturday.
- 3 **The final will be run at the scheduled heat time if insufficient competitors register on the day to justify heats.** Please note that if you report late you may be unable to run if the decision has been made to replace heats by a straight final. (If semi-finals have been scheduled but are not required, then the final will still be held at the final time.)

## Competing

- 4 Athletes must wear the vest of their first-claim affiliated Club, their County or National vest, or any other Representative vest approved by UKA. (*Rule 143 S 1 (4)*)
- 5 You are not permitted to warm up on the track until you have reported to the starter's assistant and received instructions regarding warming up.
- 6 Starting blocks are provided; personal blocks may be used if approved by the starter's assistant.
- 7 Assistance to competitors within the competition area is forbidden and may lead to disqualification. No persons other than officials and those actually competing should be on or inside the cycle track.
- 8 Under 13 athletes may not take part in both the 800 metres and 1500 metres on the same day.

## Heats and Finals

- 9 The lane draw for heats shall be random, and the draw for subsequent rounds will be made in accordance with UKA Rule 166. The draw for straight finals shall be random.
- 10 **Qualification from heats** is as follows:
 

2 heats:	First three in each heat, plus the two fastest losers, to final.
3 heats:	First two in each heat, plus the two fastest losers, to final.
4 heats:	First three in each heat, plus the four fastest losers, to two semi-finals.
5 heats:	First four in each heat, plus the four fastest losers, to three semi-finals.
6 heats:	First three in each heat, plus the six fastest losers, to three semi-finals.

**For 1500 metres:**

2 heats:	First four in each heat, plus the four fastest losers.
----------	--------------------------------------------------------

**Qualification from semi-finals** is as follows:

2 semi-finals:	First four in each semi-final, to final.
3 semi-finals:	First two in each semi-final, plus the two fastest losers, to final.

- 11 Competitors shall be excluded from participating in further events when they have qualified in preliminary rounds or heats but then do not compete further without giving a valid reason to the Referee. If a meeting extends over more than one day the exclusion shall apply to all subsequent events of the meeting. (*Rule 166 S 1 (3)*) **Therefore if you qualify for a final but do not run in it without good reason, you will not be allowed to compete again in this year's championships.**

## Protests

- 12 Any protest or objection by a competitor or team against the conduct or placing of another competitor or team in any competition or relating to any matter which may develop during the carrying out of the programme, shall be made to the appropriate Referee immediately after that competition.  
Every protest or objection lodged [as above] shall be made verbally by the individual competitor or by a member of the protesting Club.  
The Referee shall decide any protest or objection made [as above] having reviewed all the relevant information and that decision shall be final. (*Rule 146 S 1 (2)*)

## Championship Secretary

- 13 The Championship Secretary reserves the right to make any alteration to the programme which he deems necessary.
- 14 The Association cannot accept responsibility for items of property left or lost at the meeting.
- 15 **Anyone wishing to take photographs or make video recordings must register with the Championship Secretary.**
