We particularly thank Bournemouth AC for hosting a second fixture and thus providing the League with five fixtures. It was noted that this was a means for Ian Graham to bring Simon Saunders up to speed, so that he can take over organisation of next season's Bournemouth event, and there is no possibility of repeating this next season.

Treasurer's Report

The report is attached and copies of the accounts were circulated, which David Vosser has not yet audited, due to family commitments.

Acceptance of the accounts, subject to audit, was proposed by Ray Stevens, seconded by John Hoare and approved unanimously by the meeting.

New Membership Affiliation/Resignation

No resignation have been received.

It was noted that competitor participation numbers were down by about 600 (i.e. 120 average fewer per fixture) on the most recent comparable season (2019/20), particularly noticeable in the Under 13 races.
